Clean Up Spills 5

Always wipe up any garage spills, whether it's water, oil, or iquid chemicals.

Use Smart Technology 6

Try utilizing "smart" heat, smoke, and carbon monoxide detectors that alert you of issues even when you aren't home.

Check Your Outlets 7

Make sure you only have one ppliance plugged in per outlet nd that flammable materials are tored away from those areas.

Never Use Extensions 8

You should never use an extension cord when charging or powering appliances.
