Keep the garage organized to limit potential hazards.

Always wipe up any garage spills, whether it's water, oil, or liquid chemicals.

Try utilizing "smart" heat, smoke, and carbon monoxide detectors that alert you of issues even when you aren't home.

Make sure you only have one appliance plugged in per outlet and that flammable materials are stored away from those areas.

Never Use
Extensions

You should never use an extension cord when charging or powering appliances.
